- Community college graduates or transfer students must provide verification of acceptance by the school to be attended during the scholarship year as well as an **official transcript** from all colleges attended.

- The selection procedure involves a personal interview of some nominated scholarship applicants. Interviews will be conducted May 14 thru May 24, 2019.
- Each applicant will be notified of his/her status on or about June 7, 2019. All award decisions are final.
